Where does your money go?

Approximately 85% of your fees go to the Football Federation of Australia, Football Queensland, and Football Sunshine Coast. 2010 will see each player issued with a CUFC club shirt and drink bottle for the season. The remaining 15% and sponsorship money is used by CUFC on the maintenance of the clubhouse and playing fields i.e. furniture, stationary, electricity, gas, cleaning, goal posts and nets, line marker and mowing. Trophies and Presentation Day. Coaches registration and in-service development fees. Guest coaches fees. PA system. Playing jersey and all training equipment for every team. Spectator equipment. Storage sheds. Sportsmed training.
