

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Parent Participation:** CUFC is a volunteer organisation and requires the support of its members to run the club, participate in coaching and manage teams, perform field marking and maintenance, provide canteen assistance, cleaning of the facility and many more tasks.
In 2010 each age will be allocated canteen days where parents of particular age groups **WILL** be required to assist the canteen convenor.
Ground supervisors will be also required this year. Rosters will be available on the website.
- **Communication:** CUFC keeps contact primarily by email. Please ensure you allow cufcorg@cufc.org.au through your spam filter. We also communicate with coaches and managers through SMS. Please advise any changes of details so we can keep you informed. www.cufc.org.au is also a great source of information.
- **Coaching:** In relation to U6 & U7's, a team leader is required to help the children learn the game. Much assistance is given through the club and it is as not as daunting as it seems.
The requirement for U8 – U10 is for the coach to be an instructing referee. Once again courses are available that the club funds.
By the stage of reaching competitive teams coaches are usually keen parents and senior players.
- **Change Rooms:** Change rooms must be left in a clean and tidy state at the end of use. If the change rooms are in a poor state prior to your use, it is to be reported to a CUFC committee member.
- **Sunshine Coast Football Communication:** If anyone has any questions regarding anything from Sunshine Coast Football, please ask your coach or manager and if they can't answer your question please ask one of the CUFC Committee Members. If they can't answer it they will get the answer and report back. All communication should be through CUFC initially.
- **Nets:** It is the policy of CUFC that teams playing first on fields put up nets and corner flags for games with nets and both sets of nets for SSG. A team playing last on the fields' pulls them down and returns them to the sheds.
- **Player Registration:** The registrar of the club is responsible for registering all players and placing them into teams. Whilst requests for certain players to play together will be considered, this cannot always happen, and the registrar's decision is final. For U11 teams and above, teams will be graded in consultation with the coaches of that division and the Director of Coaching (DOC). It is the intention of CUFC to have all players registered play, however circumstances may be that CUFC may offer refunds or positions at other clubs if we can't attain our goal.
- **Player Communication:** It is the players' responsibility to communicate with the coach and/or manager to find out information regarding cancelled training or games due to wet weather. They are also responsible for advising them of change of email or phone numbers to keep communication lines open.
- **Referees:** Under **NO** Circumstance are Coaches, Managers or Parents to approach referees. This includes the non competitive teams. Please advise the

Club President to address any issues you may have. Failure to adhere to this will be seen as a serious offence and will be dealt with by the committee.

- **Spectators:** Spectators are not permitted between fields 1 or 2 at CUFC or . This is a safety issue.
- **Technical Areas:** Only Coaches Managers and Players are allowed in the technical area. Reserve Players are to wear bibs that are a different colour to jerseys. Team officials must have their accreditation at all times. Failure to adhere to these directions may see points deducted from the team. Rubbish **MUST** not be left in these areas as are bins provided. Please report any areas not left in a reasonable state to a CUFC committee member.
- **Alcohol:** Under no circumstance is alcohol to be taken onto the grounds at any club visited. This is a licensing issue and will **NOT** be tolerated.
- **Training Requirements:** It is a requirement that players make themselves available to train on a regular basis. Those failing to do so may find themselves as reserves on regular occasions. It is the responsibility of the player or their guardian to advise the coach of the unavailability by phone or SMS. Boots and Shin pads are a minimum requirement to train. Failing to wear these will result in no training.
- **Volunteer Levy:** It is the players/parents responsibility to fill out the appropriate form for refund of levy. Failure to do this will result in refusal.
- **Working Bee:** We encourage all members to make an effort in attending and helping with working bees. From 2010 U6-U10 teams will be responsible under committee supervision to mark the fields on the front ovals and install the goal posts and to remove them at season end. U11- senior teams will be responsible for the senior fields the same as above.
- Please remember that all CUFC Committee Members are volunteers and parents of players too. As such we have other responsibilities as well as those to do with the club. Feel free to volunteer and assist in areas where you feel something needs more attention.
