DEADLINE FOR THE 2025 SEASON

- Opening Date: December 2nd, 2024
- Closing Date: February 5th, 2025

By adhering to these deadlines, CUFC ensures a smooth and organized start to the season, enabling us to submit our team nominations on time as required by Football QLD.

Please Note: Registration does not guarantee a place in a team; it is simply an expression of interest on which team selections are based. Early registrations have an advantage, and preference will be given to returning 2024 players until 5th February. Any registrations received after the 5th of February will be put on a waitlist and allocated to a team only if there is availability.

SUMMARY

Birth Certificate/ID

All new players are required to provide a Birth Certificate (for Miniroos & Juniors) or photo identification (for seniors). These can be sighted at sign-on/information days.

SQUADI App

All registrations will be done through SQUADI so please download the app. This is also the only place to keep up to date with Fixtures, Draws, Ladders, Wet Weather and Game Venues. If you need help navigating the app please visit our website FAQ> Squadi or contact registrar@cufc.org.au

Fair Play Vouchers

Fair Play vouchers will be accepted on SQUADI and the discount will automatically be applied to fees. There is no need to email the vouchers to us anymore.

Discounts

All fees will be discounted by \$20 if you register before 5th February (No Code Required). After this date the full registration fees will be payable.

Sibling discounts are offered (1 Sibling \$10, 2 Siblings \$30, 3 Siblings \$50) and will be applied automatically. Please note for SQUADI to recognise you are a family and for the discounts to be applied correctly, each family member will need to be registered in one session. On the payment page click "+Add Another Participant" for each registration.

Sign on Days

You only need to attend a sign on day if you are a new player providing ID; or are purchasing socks/shorts; or need help registering via SQUADI.

Insurance

Player insurance is included in the FQ component of player fees. The insurance plan provides basic levels of cover for players and others participating in Football

but is not all encompassing and does not seek to replace the need for private health and other insurances. All players and officials are encouraged to take out their own private health insurance, life insurance and “Top Up” coverage over and above the coverage provided under this plan.

International Clearance

If you are new to Cooroora United FC and are not an Australian Citizen or your last registration was overseas, you will need international clearance (u10s and up). This can take a while to get through the Football Queensland system so please email the registrar ASAP after registering. This is a FIFA requirement, Cooroora United FC and Football Queensland have no jurisdiction over this.

Uniforms/Playing equipment

All playing jerseys are provided by the club.

Miniroos | (U6-U11s) & U12s will be given their jerseys at the start of season by their coaches. These are to be worn to all games and do not have to be returned to the club at the end of the season. Navy shorts & socks are required which can be purchased on our sign on days or via SQUADI upon registration.

Junior Competitive Teams | (U13s -U18s) The playing jerseys will be kept in a kit and looked after by a team coach or manager and given to players each week at games. Navy shorts & socks are required which can be purchased on our sign on days or through SQUADI upon registration.

Senior Teams | The playing jerseys will be kept in a kit and looked after by a team coach or manager and given to players each week at games. Navy shorts & socks are required which can be purchased on our sign on days or through SQUADI upon registration.

All players are to wear football boots and shinpads.

Team Preferences

REGISTRATION FEES AND PAYMENT OPTIONS

Below are set fees for the season, once a player has taken the field in game or training your FQ portion of the registration fee cannot be refunded.

You may choose to pay your fees upfront with debit/credit card or set up an instalment plan.

Instalments are paid over 5 payments. The first payment also includes the entire FQ portion of fees. Refer to fee schedule below.

1st Instalment – Due Upon Registration (Gov. Body Fees + First Instalment)

2nd Instalment – Due 14 February 2025

3rd Instalment – Due 14 March 2025

4th Instalment – Due 14 April 2025

5th Instalment - Due 14 May 2025

If you require a more flexible payment plan which can be paid weekly/fortnightly over a longer period from date of registration, please email Zorana treasurer@cufc.org.au. Please note you must email before registering as this option does not come up unless it is arranged prior.

We do not accept cash or direct deposit to the club, all payments/payment plans are to be done through SQUADI.
