REGISTRATION

Online registrations are now open! Players can register and pay online without the need to attend a sign-on venue.

You will only be required to attend a sign-on/information day if you are a new player needing to provide identification, or to purchase socks and shorts.

Sign-on / information days will be held at CUFC clubhouse, **9:00am – 1:00pm Sunday 30th January and Sunday 6th February 2022 and 3:30pm to 5:00pm Wednesday 2nd February 2022**. Computers and assistance will be available for registering online, socks and shorts will also be available for purchase.

Birth Certificate/identification – all new players are required to provide a Birth Certificate (for juniors) or photo identification (for seniors). These can be sighted at sign-on/information days.

All players, coaches, managers, and volunteers in 2022 must self-register on PlayFootball.

If registering a child for the first time, you need to create an account in your name then select 'register my child'.

PLEASE NOTE: Registration does not **guarantee** a place in a team; it is simply an expression of interest on which team selections are based. Obviously early registrations have an advantage. Preference will be given to returning 2021 players until midnight third sign-on day, 6th February 2022.

FEES

Cheaper Than Last Season!

Fee schedule is attached (see page 5). Please note that registrations on or before 6th February receive a **\$15.00 discount**. This is to encourage timely registration. The Committee is required to nominate teams for the Sunshine Coast Football (SCF) competition **by Friday February 11th 2022** - late registrations can cause disruptions in team allocations, children having to play out of their age group and playing in a team at an inappropriate level. Paysmart – is a payment plan service and is available for those not able to pay full fees up front. We do not offer in-house payment plans. Paysmart can be used for full fees or part fees, including the gap between *Fair Play* voucher value (\$150.00) and full fee. Paysmart start date can be delayed with committee member approval to help ease budget pressures. A completed Paysmart arrangement is considered payment in full regardless of instalment start date. To use Paysmart you will need to contact our Treasurer, Zorana, at treasurer@cufc.org.au.

Fair Play – is a Queensland Government support programme to assist in the affordability of sporting club fees for children 5 to under the age of 18. This programme is available to parents, carers, and guardians who hold a current Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession card, or those identified by two referral agents. Eligible children and young people are presented with a voucher that provides up to \$150 to help with the costs for membership and participation fees. For more information and how to apply, visit

Fair Play Round 6 applications open Wednesday 19th of January 2022. The funds available are limited so best not to delay.

NB. If using a Fair Play voucher, best to pay direct into CUFC account. Please just pay the total fee less the \$150 voucher value. Fair Play vouchers can be emailed, for simplicity, to our Treasurer, Zorana, at treasurer@cufc.org.au.

TEAM PREFERENCES

All players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the Sunshine Coast Football's Player Age Policy and the 2022 Player Age Eligibility. **Players will only be able to register in their own age group** on PlayFootball; however, consideration will be given to requests to play outside of this age group. Any team preference requests (including team preferences within own age group) must be submitted before **midday 6th February**, at sign-on or by email to registrar@cufc.org.au. Although every effort will be made to meet requests for particular team allocations, *the committee is unable to guarantee such requests will be met*. The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered at the time, immediately after third sign-on/information day, 6th February. Team preferences after 6th February will only be considered if already formed teams are not affected.

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

MiniRoos wear black shorts, royal blue socks. **Ages 12 and up** wear navy shorts, navy socks.

Socks and shorts for juniors will be available for purchase at sign-on / information days. After this date we will advise when available subject to volunteer availability to handle sales. Socks are \$15, shorts \$25.

Player jerseys: U12 to U18 are provided by the Club in team kits looked after by the team manager. U6 to U11 will be given one at the beginning of the season for the player to keep.

Boots and shin pads are required for training and games; Intersport Noosa is the preferred provider – mention CUFC to receive a 10% discount on soccer merchandise.

TRAINING

Training commences as soon as teams are formed and coaches are ready to go. Training days are dependent on Coach availability. Managers will contact players advising them of training times.

GAME DAY INFORMATION

All game day information is available on [Sunshine Coast Football](#) website.

Game venues: vary depending on team/division/draw. All draws are determined by Sunshine Coast Football. Games/carnivals may be held at any club within SCF.

Age Groups

MiniRoos (Non-competitive, male and female mixed teams) –

Under 6, Under 7, Under 8, Under 9, Under 10, Under 11, Under 12 (If sufficient numbers we will have Girls Under 6/7, Under 8/9 and Under 11)

Competitive –

Male: Under 13
Under 14
Under 15
Under 17
Senior Men
Over 35s

Female: Under 13
Under 15
Senior Women

Team numbers

U6/7 teams play 4-a-side with no goalkeeper, maximum of 3 substitutes.

U8/9 teams play 7-a-side, including goal keeper, maximum of 4 substitutes.

U10/11 teams play 9-a-side, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

U12 Boys play 9-a-side, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

U13 to Senior teams have eleven players, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

Rescheduled Matches i.e. Washed out games

Re-schedules due to wet weather usually take place as follows:

1. Friday night matches to the following Tuesday night
2. Saturday Senior matches to the following Wednesday night
3. Saturday Junior matches - U16 and U18 matches to mid-week
4. Saturday Junior matches - U12, U13, U14 matches to Sunday week
5. U10/11s **Kangaroos** matches to Sunday week

All competitive matches must be re-scheduled and played. In the first instance Under 10 Kangaroos and Under 11 Kangaroos will be re-scheduled and must be played, however if the match is required to be re-scheduled a second time clubs can apply for the match not to be played.

INSURANCE

Player insurance is included in the FQ component of player fees. The insurance plan provides basic levels of cover for players and others participating in Football, but is not all encompassing and does not seek to replace the need for private health and other insurances. All players and officials are encouraged to take out their own private health insurance, life insurance and 'Top Up' coverage over and above the coverage provided under this plan.
