# **Information Pack 2023**

- Registrations are open from January 9<sup>th</sup> 2023
- Registrations need to be finalised by 4<sup>th</sup> February 2023
- Players can register and pay online without attending a sign-on venue
- Payment can be made via Play Football or direct deposit to CUFC
- Fair Play voucher discount are applied by the club treasurer, see page 2 for more information
- You <u>will only be required</u> to attend a sign-on/information day if you are a new player needing to provide identification, or to purchase socks and shorts
- Account holders must be over 18 years, if registering a child for the first time, you need to create an
  account for the parent /guardian and then register your child
- \$15.00 discount for registrations received by 4<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023

**Birth Certificate/identification** – all <u>new</u> players are required to provide a Birth Certificate (for juniors) or photo identification (for seniors). These can be sighted at sign-on/information days.

All players, coaches, managers, and volunteers in 2023 must self register on Play Football

Registration does not guarantee a place in a team; it is simply an expression of interest on which team selections are based. Obviously early registrations have an advantage. Preference will be given to returning 2022 players until midnight 4th February 2023.

#### **FEES**

**Fair Play** is a Queensland Government support programme to assist affordability of sporting club fees for children 5 to under the age of 18. This programme is available to parents, carers, and guardians who hold a current Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession card, or those identified by two referral agents. Eligible children and young people are presented with a voucher that provides up to \$150 to help with the costs for membership and participation fees. ## **TEAM PREFERENCES**

Players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the <u>Football QLD Player Eligibility Policy</u> Players will only be able to register in their own age group on Play Football; however, consideration will be given to requests to play outside of age groups. Any team preference requests can be submitted at the sign-on day or by email to <u>registrar@cufc.org.au</u> and must be received by 1pm 4th February. Although every effort is made to meet requests for team allocations, the committee is unable to guarantee such requests will be met. The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered by 4th February 2023, team preferences after this date will only be considered if formed teams are not affected.

#### PLAYING EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

**C**UFC colours are navy shorts and socks (Please note this season we are moving to one single consistent uniform from miniroos to seniors).

Players require:

- Socks (\$15) and shorts (\$25) will be available for purchase at sign-on / information days. After sign on days, purchase will be subject to volunteer availability
- Boots and shin pads are required for training and games; Intersport Noosa is the preferred provider mention CUFC to receive a 10% discount on soccer merchandise.
- Player jerseys- Under 6s to U12s are given a jersey to keep at the beginning of the season. Under 13s to 18s and senior's jerseys are looked after by the team managers and remain the property of CUFC.

Discounted socks and shorts combo for Miniroos (under 6 to under 11) are \$20 for this season only

#### **TRAINING**

Training commences as soon as teams are formed and Coaches are ready to go. Training days are dependent on volunteer Coach availability. Coaches and Managers will contact players advising them of training times.

### **GAME DAY INFORMATION**

All game day information is available on <u>Sunshine Coast Football</u> website. Game venues vary depending on team/division/draw. All draws are determined by Football QLD. Games/carnivals may be held at any club within Sunshine Coast Football.

#### **Age Groups**

- <u>MiniRoos</u> (Non-competitive, male and female mixed teams). Under 6 to Under 12 (If sufficient numbers we will have Girls Under 9 and Under 11)
- Competitive

Male: Under 13 Female: Under 13 Under 14 Under 14

Under 15 Under 16 Under 16 Senior Women

Under 18 Social Women (Subject to numbers)

Senior Men Over 35s

Over 45s (subject to numbers)

#### **Team numbers**

- **U6/7 teams** play 4-a-side with no goalkeeper, maximum of 3 substitutes.
- **U8/9 teams** play 7-a-side, including goal keeper, maximum of 4 substitutes.
- **U10/11 teams** play 9-a-side, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.
- **U12 /13** play 9-a-side, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.
- **U14 to Senior teams** have eleven players, including goalkeeper, maximum of 5 substitutes.

#### Rescheduled Matches i.e. Washed out games

Re-schedules due to wet weather usually take place as follows:

- 1. Friday night matches to the following Tuesday night
- 2. Saturday senior matches to the following Wednesday night
- 3. Saturday junior matches U16 and U18 matches to mid-week
- 4. Saturday junior matches U13, U14, U15 matches to Sunday week
- 5. U10/11s **Kangaroos** matches to Sunday week

All competitive matches must be re-scheduled and played. In the first instance Under 10 Kangaroos and Under 11 Kangaroos will be re-scheduled and must be played, however if the match is required to be rescheduled a second time clubs can apply for the match not to be played.

#### **INSURANCE**

Player insurance is included in the FQ component of player fees. The insurance plan provides basic levels of cover for players and others participating in Football, but is not all encompassing and does not seek to replace the need for private health and other insurances. All players and officials are encouraged to take out their own private health insurance, life insurance and 'Top Up' coverage over and above the coverage provided under this plan.
